Dear Dr Kleftouris

l am writing to confirm that Mr Mike Salampasis successfully completed a project at the University of Teesside during the period April to September 1993 .

The project that Mr Salampasis undertook involved the implementation of certain Task Management functions of a Cooperating Knowledge Base System (CKBS), in C++. The project was very demanding in that the concepts involved were complex and difficult to understand, and progress with programming required a high level of competence in C++. Mr Salampasis made very good progress indeed. Largely acting on his own initiative he identified and read additional relevant literature (eg DAI papers on Contract Net concepts), and he produced a C++ implementation of these concepts. His performance, in my opinion, corresponds to the standard required for UK students to be awarded First or Upper Second Class Honours Degrees.

Mr Salampasis attended a conference at Keele University on CKBS with myself and a colleague, In September. I am in the process of submitting a research paper, the first of several, which refers to his work and which will have him as a co-author.

We would be very keen to accommodate further Erasmus students who might be interested in a placement here, especially if they are of the calibre of Mr
